

Tour of the Century, Sep 10 – 24, 2008 – Terms, Conditions & Registration Form

COST OF THE TOUR

\$4,595 per person, double occupancy

\$9,190 per couple double occupancy

Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours sell out early, so we strongly suggest you book early to reserve your space. After **November 1, 2007**, add \$150 per person. Tour prices could also be affected by additional costs for airfare and/or the Euro.

Registration deposit: To register and reserve your space, send a minimum of \$250 per person. You have the option to pay in full to lock in your tour cost with a full refund up to **November 1, 2007** except \$50 per person admin fee. To keep our costs to an absolute minimum, we do not accept credit cards.

Second Payment is due November 1, 2007: \$2,500 per person for a total of \$3,000 with initial registration deposit. (50% of required deposit is non-refundable.)

Final Payment due June 1, 2008: Total balance due. (100% non-refundable – recommend travel insurance.)

Tour Cancellation / Interruption & Medical Insurance: We strongly urge you to give favorable consideration to coverage which provides financial protection for expenses related to cancellation, interruption and medical expenses caused by a covered reason as stated in the policy. This coverage pays for loss of deposits and additional expense due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, medical expense, emergency assistance and accidental death. Foreign exchange: The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.40 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.42 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to prepay your trip early. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar. Since we must forecast and make deposits far in advance, there are no refunds should the Euro decrease.

Not included: Entrance fees to attractions not listed as advertised, excess baggage, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, beverages, lunches, two evening meals, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. **Single room supplements** are available for singles wishing to have a private room for an additional \$400 per person

Responsibility: We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for your vacation. However, we do not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of these independent suppliers, over whom we have no direct control. Please understand also that we cannot control such factors as weather, government travel restrictions, mechanical breakdowns, your physical, medical or mental disabilities, your failure to obtain proper travel documents or your failure to follow travel instructions. Every effort will be made to provide you with the service and places of interest we have described to you, however, all prices, descriptions, activity scheduling and places of interest are subject to change without notice if we feel it would be beneficial to the group. Airline Tickets: We will notify you of which airline we will be using and will provide you with your airline schedule as soon as we have made your reservations. Your tickets will be sent to you approximately three weeks prior to departure. It is your responsibility to have valid passports and tickets available at your port of departure. If you are departing before or returning later than the scheduled tour, or wish to purchase the land package only, please let us know your intentions not later than **November 1, 2007.**

Land Package Only: If you wish to do your own air arrangements, subtract **\$750 per person.** You will be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport or at our Hotel in Grassau. If you are doing your own air arrangements and are unable to meet our bus, we can arrange shuttle transportation to or from the hotel at your expense. Meet the Staff

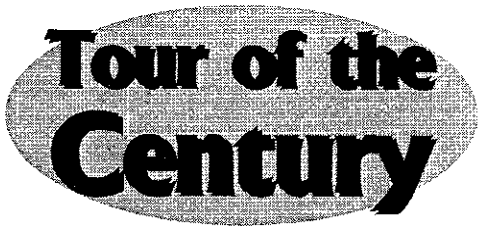

His tours took him as a featured caller to all 50 states all Provinces of Canada and several countries throughout the world. Jerry helped establish CALLERLAB and served on the board for a decade. He was later awarded the CALLERLAB milestone award. He is the recipient of three gold records. Jerry & Sherry have been married over 50 years; have two daughters and one grandson. Jerry became semi-retired in 2001 where he continues to call but not 365 days a year.

Gary Shoemaker started calling in Tulsa, OK in 1964 and went full time in 1968. His travels have taken him to all 50 states, as well as Canada, Mexico, England, Scotland, New Zealand, Japan, Sweden, Germany and Denmark. Gary, Lisa and daughter Katie make their home in the Smoky Mountains of Tennessee. During the winter months, they live in Mesa AZ where Gary calls a full program from beginners through A-2. After many years of being co-owner of Chaparral Records with Ken Bower, Jerry Haag and Marshall Flippo they decided to sell the label to Palomino Records. Although these callers still do several Chaparral Weekends around the nation, Gary now records freelance for several companies including Chaparral, Rhythm, ESP, Blue Star, and Crown.

Marshall Flippo has been a full time national caller for the past 50 years, an inspiration in the square dance industry. Marshall & Sharon now live in Tucson, AZ. Marshall conducts a full square dance program at the Rincon Country West RV Park and still finds time to travel around the country doing festivals and special dances. Flip has recorded countless records, including two gold recordings on Blue Star Records and is the recipient of the prestigious CALLERLAB Milestone Award. Flippo continues to display endless stamina as one of the most popular callers of our time.

Ken Bower was first introduced to square dancing in 1961 and within 1 year starting calling. By 1965 he was traveling full time. He has called in every state in the US along with Australia, China, England, Germany, Japan, New Zealand, Taiwan and Sweden to name a few. He records on several different recording labels. He works at Golden Village Palms Travel Trailer Park in Hemet, CA from Oct-Apr calling dances and teaching classes from beginners to advance. During the summer he travels calling one-night stands and working square dance weekends. Ken and his wife, Dec, come from Iowa and moved to California in 1973. They have three children, six grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Tom & Gina, your tour hosts, are from Tucson AZ where they operate a self-care horse ranch. Gina, now retired from the restaurant business, knows how to cater to people.
